GRR-RIPPER

Every once in a while you come across a wood working product that jumps out and says, "You need me". I first saw the GRR-Ripper at a woodworking show about 10 years ago. Since then, I'm on my second one and have given some away as presents to

family members. Yes, I have dinged up my first one, however I still have my fingers. This push block will straddle the table saw blade, slide along the fence keeping you out of harms way. It will cut as thin as 1/4 inch and with an optional side leg will

allow a cut as thin as 1/8 inch.
